Other Schools That Have Benefited From The Program!

Here are some recent examples of PCL supported schools:

Mackay Christian College (MCC)

Vines Creek Wetland Project 2018-19.

PCL & MCC working with the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority, secured funding through the Reef Guardian School program to enhance the natural values of the schools wetland. PCL has worked closely with MCC from writing the grant proposal, planning the revegetation, hosting a planting day with the students, and planning/installing a new sign for the wetland.



Great Northern Clean-up
